Hi Mark -

I just got off of a conference call with the Board of Directors and we spoke about this property.

You are correct. The drainage ditch/catch pond on the west side of the main canal can be eliminated and filled in.

Also, the Board would approve a pivot install that would bridge the main canal. Obviously, the district would reserve the right to review/approve the bridging structures to ensure that they are high quality bridges that wouldn't create a failure risk. Also, we would demand irrigation scheduling that would not result in the pivot blocking the canal patrol road during the time from 6:00 am - noon, allowing for our ditchriders to be able to travel this section of canal while moving water each day.

Additionally, we would plan to rock this section of patrol road at a future time allowing for travel even under wet conditions, however, until that gets accomplished, we would demand that the canal/road area be un-irrigated, i.e. the pivot doesn't deliver water as it walks over the canal and patrol road on each pass.
