



The traffic counts shown on this map represent estimates of the Annual Average Daily Traffic (AADT) and Annual Average Daily Truck Traffic (AADTT) for the year ending December 31, 2021. These estimates are developed mainly from 24-hour volumes recorded by portable traffic counters. These short-term counts are adjusted for day-of-week and seasonal variations using data from continuous permanent counters. AADT's that are developed from continuous permanent counters are underlined. An axle correction factor has been applied to each short-term count. AADT's are developed from vehicle classification counts. These classification count tocations are indicated by bold numbers on the map. AADT's at other locations are estimated from nearby counts on the same route or from other routes known to have similar traffic characteristics.
